

STATE OF ALASKA  
SCHOOL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Authority: 4AAC 0.6.055

Registration: **NO SHOTS - NO SCHOOL**

1. Beginning in the 2001-02 school year, all students enrolling/enrolled in Alaskan schools, grades preschool-12, must have a record which documents all doses and dates for all vaccines received.
2. Children transferring from one Alaskan school to another or who are new to a district are required to provide a visual record to the new school **BEFORE ENTRY**.
3. Children transferring from schools outside Alaska to an Alaskan school must have a visual record with dates for all doses appropriate to age. In addition, parents of any student entering an Alaska school for the first time must provide to the principal, documentation of having a physical examination by a physician within the past year. If the parent is unable to provide proper documentation of a previous physical exam, evidence of an appointment for a physical is due at time of enrollment.
4. The following immunizations should be documented:
  - **DTP/DTaP/DT/Td** x 3 (Booster due every 10 years)  
(Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
  - **OPV, IPV** x 3  
(Polio)
  - **MMR** x 2 (1<sup>st</sup> dose after 1 year old)  
(Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
  - **Hepatitis A** x 2 (6 months apart)
  - **Hepatitis B** x 3

If you cannot provide documentation of immunizations, your child can be taken to the Public Health Nurse and receive a booster which will allow your child to enter school. For records provided: our school nurse will review the records provided and advise if any updates will be necessary.
